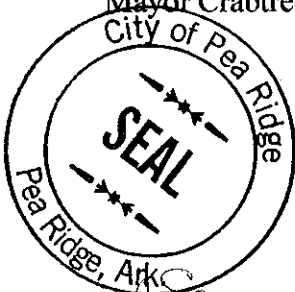


Mayor Crabtree called the Public Hearing to order.


Mayor Crabtree stated the purpose for the Public Hearing is to determine the appropriate amount of clean-up expenses for properties located at 590 Ray Street, 400 West Pickens, 530 Nelson Court, and 480 Nelson Court belonging to Michael Botson and Patricia Botson. These properties were in violation of Pea Ridge Ordinance No. 5-04.02 and the City of Pea Ridge requested the property owner bring the properties into compliance with City Code. Because no action was taken the City was required to clean up and remove certain items from the properties. The City incurred significant labor, dump and administrative costs of approximately \$11,297.51 for the clean up expenses. If this matter is not resolved the City shall file a lien against each of the properties in the amount certified by the Council.

No one was present to speak on behalf of the property owners.

Mayor Crabtree closed the Public Hearing.
