

Pea Ridge City Council
Regular Meeting
May 19, 2009

The Pea Ridge City Council met in a Regular Council Meeting on Tuesday, May 19, 2009, at 7:00 p.m., in the Council Room at City Hall.

Those present were: Mayor Jackie Crabtree, Recorder Sandy Button, Aldermen Jack Kelly, John Cody, and Nadine Telgemeier. Also present were City Attorneys Howard Slinkard and Andrew Huntsinger. Absent was: Alderman Bob Cottingham.

Others present were: Tony Townsend, Larry Majors, Tim Ledbetter, Ken Hayes, Annette Beard, Gary France, and Chris Glass.

Mayor Crabtree called the meeting to order.

Mayor Crabtree opened the meeting in prayer and led those present in the Pledge of Allegiance.

Mayor Crabtree stated that the Council had met as a Committee of the Whole prior to tonight's meeting and interviewed Jack Kelly for the Alderman vacancy of Ward 1, Position 1. Alderman Cody moved, seconded by Alderwoman Telgemeier to appoint Jack Kelly to the vacant alderman position of Ward 1, Position 1. On a roll call vote the following voted: John Cody voted aye; Nadine Telgemeier voted aye; and Jackie Crabtree voted aye. Motion passed.

Mayor Crabtree administered the Oath of Office to newly appointed Alderman Jack Kelly for Ward 1, Position 1.

Alderwoman Telgemeier, seconded by Alderman Cody, moved to approve the minutes of the April 21, 2009 Regular Meeting. The roll being called, the vote was as follows: Jack Kelly abstained; John Cody voted aye; Nadine Telgemeier voted aye; and Jackie Crabtree voted aye. Motion passed unanimously.

Alderwoman Telgemeier, seconded by Alderman Cody, moved to introduce Ordinance Number 487 by title only. The roll being called, the vote was as follows: Jack Kelly abstained; John Cody voted aye; Nadine Telgemeier voted aye; and Jackie Crabtree voted aye. Motion passed.

Mayor Crabtree read Ordinance Number 487, which is entitled:

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING PEA RIDGE
MUNICIPAL CODE, SECTION 3.08.01; DECLARING
AN EMERGENCY; AND FOR OTHER PURPOSES.

Alderman Cody, seconded by Alderwoman Telgemeier, moved that the rule requiring the reading of an ordinance by title only on three different days be suspended. Mayor Crabtree put the question on the adoption of the motion and the roll being called, the vote was as follows: Jack Kelly voted aye; John Cody voted aye; and Nadine Telgemeier voted aye. Motion passed.

Thereupon Mayor Crabtree declared that at least two-thirds of all members of the council have voted in favor of the motion to suspend the rule. The motion was carried and the rule suspended. Mayor Crabtree then read the Ordinance by title only.

Alderman Cody, seconded by Alderwoman Telgemeier, moved that the Ordinance be adopted. The question was put by Mayor Crabtree on the adoption of the motion and the roll being called, the vote was as follows: Jack Kelly voted aye; John Cody voted aye; and Nadine Telgemeier voted aye. Motion passed.

Alderman Cody, seconded by Alderwoman Telgemeier, moved that the Emergency Clause be adopted. The question was put by Mayor Crabtree on the adoption of the motion and the roll being called, the vote was as follows: Jack Kelly voted aye; John Cody voted aye; and Nadine Telgemeier voted aye. Motion passed.

The Mayor thereupon declared the Ordinance adopted and signed the Ordinance, which was attested by the City Recorder and sealed with the Seal of the City.

Mayor Crabtree stated that one bid had been received for the Animal Service Contract for the care and disposition of dogs picked up within Pea Ridge. This bid is listed below:

Pea Ridge Veterinary Clinic – Gary France: Total Cost Per Dog \$ 115.00

Mayor Crabtree stated that Dr. France had been doing this service for the City of Pea Ridge since 1977.

Alderman Cody moved, seconded by Alderman Kelly to accept the bid as listed. Motion passed unanimously.

Mayor Crabtree read Resolution Number 305, which is entitled:

A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE MAYOR AND CITY RECORDER TO EXECUTE AN AGREEMENT WITH DOCTOR GARY FRANCE TO PROVIDE VETERINARY SERVICES TO THE CITY OF PEA RIDGE, ARKANSAS.

May 19, 2009

Alderman Kelly moved, seconded by Alderman Cody to approve Resolution Number 305 as read. Motion passed unanimously.

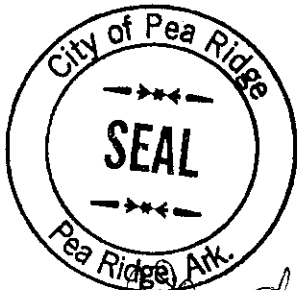
Alderman Cody moved, seconded by Alderman Kelly to set the dates for the Agreement between the City of Pea Ridge and Gary W. France, D.V.M. doing business as Pea Ridge Veterinary Clinic from May 19, 2009 to May 19, 2011, making the agreement for two years. Motion passed unanimously.



Mayor Crabtree stated that the Pea Ridge Farmers Market will begin this Thursday, May 21, 2009, from 2:00 p.m. to 7:00 p.m. at the Emergency Services Building.


