Mayor Crabtree called the meeting to order.

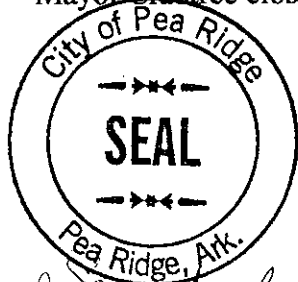
Mayor Crabtree opened the meeting in prayer and led those present in the Pledge of Allegiance.


Mayor Crabtree called the Public Hearing to order.
